

## Staff Clinical Psychologist

The Center for Psychiatric Oncology & Behavioral Sciences at the Massachusetts General Hospital (MGH) Cancer Center is seeking to hire a full-time (32-40 hours per week) clinical psychologist with expertise in health psychology and psycho-oncology. The position will involve a combination of direct clinical care, coordination of services, and collaboration with multidisciplinary teams to implement novel models of care delivery. The Center for Psychiatric Oncology & Behavioral Sciences is a premier clinical and research program staffed by clinical psychologists, psychiatrists and social workers who provide comprehensive clinical services and conduct innovative research to meet the psychosocial needs of patients with cancer and their families.

### Primary Responsibilities:

- Conduct clinical assessments and psychotherapy (individual and group) with adults undergoing treatment for cancer, survivors, and their caregivers
- Assist with overseeing referrals and coordination of services among psychology, psychiatry and social work
- Collaborate with multidisciplinary teams to develop and implement care models that improve access to mental health services for the Cancer Center's population of patients with cancer
- Provide clinical supervision for psychology interns and fellows
- Assist with the clinical research program by serving as a study interventionist on supportive care clinical trials

### Position Requirements:

- PhD/PsyD in clinical psychology from an APA-accredited doctoral program
- License-eligible to practice in Massachusetts
- Qualified for an academic appointment at Harvard Medical School at the rank of Instructor
- Training in health psychology with expertise in evidence-based treatments such as CBT and ACT
- At least two years of experience post-fellowship in working with patients with cancer preferred
