

**Clinical Psychologist Position in Psycho-oncology

The Siteman Psychology Service is seeking a clinical psychologist with a background in health psychology or psycho-oncology who is license eligible in the state of Missouri. Siteman Cancer Center is affiliated with Barnes-Jewish Hospital and Washington University School of Medicine in St. Louis, MO.

The Siteman Psychology Service provides excellent psychological care to enhance the well-being, quality of life, and overall health of those affected by cancer (cancer patients/survivors, family, caregivers). We provide clinical training in psycho-oncology to psychology doctoral students from Washington University, St. Louis University, and University of Missouri, St. Louis, and rotations through the St. Louis VA's internship program. We also support and facilitate medical education at Washington University School of Medicine, produce scholarly work in psycho-oncology, and deliver community outreach and education. Candidates should hold a doctoral degree from a Psychology graduate program accredited by the American Psychological Association (APA). Completion of an APA/CPA accredited internship is required. Postdoctoral training in health psychology is desirable.

The Siteman Cancer Center at Barnes-Jewish Hospital and Washington University School of Medicine is an international leader in cancer treatment, research, prevention, education and community outreach. It is the only cancer center in Missouri to hold the prestigious Comprehensive Cancer Center designation and "Exceptional" rating from the National Cancer Institute and membership in the National Comprehensive Cancer Network.
