A Clinical Psychologist with Psycho-Oncology training and experience is a vital part of a comprehensive cancer treatment team. The Psychologist provides comprehensive psychosocial services and programs through all phases of the cancer experience for both patients and the families. These services include clinical consultation and assessment, treatment of psychosocial concerns through individual, couples, family, or group therapy, psychoeducation, mind-body therapies such as yoga, relaxation, and meditation, and bereavement and grief counseling. This professional will be part of an integrative team-

based approach to supportive care of the patient and family. The psychologist will work closely with medical and radiation oncology and palliative care, as well as other members of the supportive care team, to provide quality care and to continue to develop and grow the services offered to our patients and families.
