The Ochsner Health fellowship will reside within the Department of Psychiatry which will provide opportunities to work and collaborate with psychiatrists, medical psychologists, clinical psychologists, psychiatric nurse practitioners, physician assistants, and social workers. Post-doctoral fellows will be working half of their time integrated in the Primary Care setting and half their time integrated in the Department of Oncology. Fellows will learn brief assessment and intervention skills to improve the health, habits, and behaviors of a culturally diverse patient population across the lifespan. Patients are referred to Primary Care Behavioral Health and Psychosocial Oncology for all types of mental health concerns, including physical health problems such as coping with chronic illnesses, adherence concerns, health behavior modification, as well as more traditional behavioral health problems requiring short-term treatment. Our program offers an excellent opportunity to learn skills for behavioral consultation in Primary Care and Oncology. Applicants should have experience with or be highly interested in working as an integrated member of a highly collaborative interdisciplinary team. Completion of an APA-accredited internship and a PhD or PsyD in clinical, health, or counseling psychology is required. The fellowship stipend allows for \$50,000 in addition to staff benefits.
