The Miami Cancer Institute is seeking a consult-liaison trained psychiatrist with experience in psycho-oncology. The Cancer Support clinicians work collaboratively with multi-disciplinary oncologists in a state-of-the-art innovative cancer center. Duties include providing direct psychiatric care to cancer patients throughout the continuum of cancer care. All clinical care occurs in an ambulatory patient-centered setting with an inter-disciplinary care model. Educational and programmatic development opportunities are encouraged and available.
