Administratively housed within the Rehabilitation Division, the TGH Psychology & Neuropsychology team provide assessment, consultation, and treatment for both adult and pediatric populations throughout the continuum of care. In addition to rehabilitation and trauma populations, psychological and neuropsychological services are provided for burn, neuroscience, oncology and general medical populations. Psychology & Neuropsychology staff represent a high degree of specialization in treating individuals with medical, rehabilitation, and neuropsychological needs informed by a biopsychosocial model of care. Psychologists have key leadership roles within their multidisciplinary teams and participate in teaching, applied clinical research, and team building/support activities.
