### Special Issue on Global Psycho-Oncology

We are pleased to announce a call for papers for a Special Issue on **Global Psycho-Oncology**. The deadline for manuscript submission is **31<sup>st</sup> March 2022**

The focus will be on:

*Research emanating from lower-and-middle-income countries (LMICs) on the psychological, social and cultural dimensions of cancer and cancer treatment and on interventions to improve or to maintain psychological well-being, social functioning and/or quality of life in this population. This research may involve collaborations with investigators in other regions and the Journal will also work to facilitate support for submissions from researchers for whom necessary support is not locally available.*

*Papers recognizing the importance of emerging research and knowledge translation, research protocols and case studies from LMIC's that advance knowledge in the field of psycho-oncology will also be considered.*

This special issue seeks to publish innovative, timely, and high impact original research papers, brief research reports [Clinical Correspondence], and reviews on Global Psycho-Oncology.

Commentaries are by invitation only.

We encourage submission of relevant manuscripts across the cancer continuum from prevention through early detection, treatment, survivorship, and end-of-life care.

The following cross-cutting topics are of particular interest:

- Screening and assessment
- Disparities and stigma
- Theoretical and conceptual issues
- Cost-effectiveness
- Intervention testing;
- Dissemination and implementation.
