Job Summary

The health psychologist will join a team of psychology and psychiatry colleagues in the Psycho-oncology program within the Department of Palliative and Supportive Care. The role focuses primarily on clinical care with cancer patients, and their families and caregivers, with a variety of cancer diagnoses and cancer stages. Care delivery is supported by an interdisciplinary team which includes social work, nursing, palliative medicine, and medical and radiation oncology. Opportunities in education, research and quality improvement are also available. Candidates should have clinical experience and appropriate training in working with adult cancer patients and their families.

License/Certification

Applicants must have completed a doctoral degree from an APA- or CPA-accredited psychology program, completed an internship with experience in clinical health psychology and a post-doctoral fellowship. Eligibility for licensure in Ohio is essential.
