

## **Health Psychologist Faculty Position in Psychosocial Oncology and Diabetes Care UW Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences**

**Title:** Open Rank Psychologist Position WOT in Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences – University of Washington / Seattle Cancer Care Alliance

### **Position Description**

University of Washington invites applications for a full-time or part-time psychologist position in the Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences. This faculty position will focus primarily on clinical care and will also have opportunities for teaching/supervision and collaborative research.

This position will provide psychological assessment and treatment at Seattle Cancer Care Alliance (SCCA) and University of Washington through a mix of in-person care and telehealth. This position will work with cancer and diabetes patients, and their families and caregivers. The SCCA Psychosocial Oncology Program is built on a multidisciplinary collaborative care model. Starting on July 1, 2022, the program will also have psychology residents providing clinical services and this position will have the opportunity to provide clinical supervision to trainees. <https://www.seattlecca.org/services/psychiatry>

The SCCA, which is commonly ranked as one of the Top 10 cancer centers nationally, is housed at Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center, one of its partner institutions, home to three Nobel Prize winners, and the only National Cancer Institute Designated comprehensive cancer center in the Washington, Wyoming, Alaska, Montana, Idaho (WWAMI) region. The UW School of Medicine has emerged as the leading public medical school in NIH research funding while simultaneously ranking as the number one rated medical school in primary care training.

The Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences is the third largest department within the School of Medicine with 285 full-time faculty members, 515 clinical faculty members, and over 200 staff. <https://psychiatry.uw.edu>
