Department Chair, Health Outcomes & Behavior (HOB)

We seek a mid-level or senior career faculty member to lead the Health Outcomes and Behavior Department (HOB) in the Division of Population Sciences. This position offers an exciting visionary opportunity to build upon Moffitt's exceptional history of community engagement and large patient volume to accelerate research on behavioral interventions, cancer prevention and early detection, and cancer survivorship, with an emphasis on health equity. Candidates with a dynamic research program in one or more of these areas are encouraged to apply. The successful candidate may also serve as the Co-Leader of the Cancer Center Support Grant (CCSG) research program, if mutually desirable.

THE DEPARTMENT DETAILS

The HOB Department houses 19 faculty members engaged in team-oriented cancer prevention and control research, and together with the Cancer Epidemiology Department, constitutes Moffitt's vibrant Division of Population Sciences. The overarching goal of HOB is to understand and intervene at multiple levels, including individuals, social networks, healthcare systems, communities, and beyond to prevent cancer, detect it earlier, and improve outcomes. HOB members conduct research across the cancer continuum, from prevention, screening, and diagnosis to active treatment, long-term survivorship, and end-of-life. HOB members also engage in research that addresses cancer disparities. Importantly, department members are highly collaborative, deeply engaged in the community, and are well integrated with clinical care at Moffitt. This engagement and integration inform clinically important research questions of high relevance to the catchment area and advance the translation of research findings into beneficial evidence-based interventions and changes in health care policies.

IDEAL CANDIDATE

Successful candidates must have PhD or MD and relevant research, administrative, and leadership experience. An active, funded research program in cancer prevention or control and a strong history of peer-reviewed funding and publication are also required. Candidates must also have a demonstrated trajectory of leadership growth; mentoring skills; and have engaged in successful collaborative, multidisciplinary research.

We strive to be the leader in understanding in the complexity of cancer through team science and applying those insights for human benefits. Established resources for conducting research include the center's transdisciplinary departments, including a new Department of Machine Learning, diverse networks of community partners, a state-wide affiliate network of treatment providers, several research centers of excellence, and shared resources devoted to participant-reported outcomes measurement and biostatistics/bioinformatics. Moreover, Moffitt is a leader in the development of clinical care pathways and integration of patient reported outcomes into clinical care that lend themselves to applied research. Moffitt has also been recognized nationally and locally as a leader in diversity, equity and inclusion.
